
To support the above policies and the safety and welfare of all participants Motorsport UK will:

- Act upon any Safeguarding or welfare concern that is identified or raised to any member of the eBRC team and pass this information to Motorsport UK within 24 hours to [safeguarding@motorsportuk.org](mailto:safeguarding@motorsportuk.org)
- Ensure verification of the age of all participants, where a participant is under the age of 18 registration will only be completed with parental consent
- Ensure that at the time of registration all participants and where relevant all parents/carers will be emailed the Motorsport UK Esport participant welfare document (this will also be available on [www.britishrallychampionship.co.uk](http://www.britishrallychampionship.co.uk)).
- Ensure participants will not be able to communicate between themselves at any time whilst accessing the Esport platform with all webcams and microphones access blocked
- Ensure participants contact and personal details will not be openly visible to other users. details will be held on the Motorsport UK Database and will be subject to Motorsport UK GDPR

It is the responsibility of all parties to ensure that they adhere to the terms of this agreement.
