## **FIA IMPACT DATA RECORDER (IDR) TEST COORDINATED BY MOTORSPORT UK**

Motorsport UK are conducting a test in conjunction with the FIA to experiment a low-cost IDR. The BRC has been selected by Motorsport UK to assist with gathering data from the IDR. The project is aimed to improve safety in high level and grass roots motorsport in a cost-effective manner. The device itself (photographed) measures at 6cm and 12 grams and will not interrupt drivers. This is designed to be a 'fit and forget', installed via adhesive with a battery life of two-years. The device logs accelerations 1,600 times per second and records high impact data.

When the cars are inspected by the BRC Technical Team these devices will be affixed to the vehicle towards the center line of the car – this will likely be somewhere on the transmission tunnel. The trackers are to be kept on the vehicle throughout the 2022 season. If vehicles are used on other events outside of the BRC they are to be kept in place to continue gathering data. **There is no cost associated with this test.**
